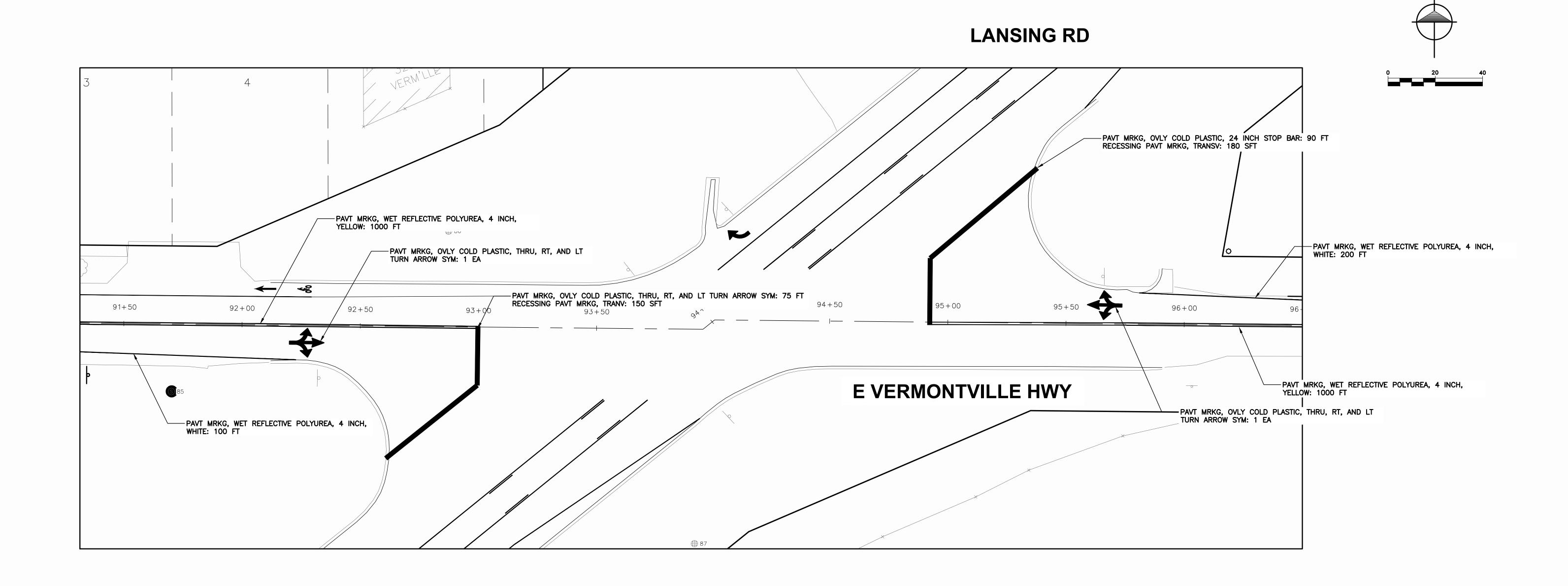
TIFA Estimated Funds for Capital Projects is about \$153,939.42 – This is to Plan for the new Fiscal budget 2022-2023.

- 1. TIFA Sidewalk corridor development project under current specifications. This is consistent with your Development Plan and sub-area plans of TIFA. A low bid price at this time with contingencies and engineering for a 6 foot concrete sidewalk is about \$88.29 per linear foot. Again, this includes associated costs of 10% contingencies and costs for engineering and inspection. Your TIFA Development Plan and City Master Plan encourages interconnectivity of walkways that adds synergy from existing assets. Each sidewalk section that is connected to an existing sidewalk grid creates additional recreation value from prior investments. Closing gaps in a sidewalk grid for example is known to increase use of the grid, not just that that portion of new sidewalk.
 - ✓ Sidewalk extension on east side of Lake Alliance Drive into Lake Alliance to Softball Complex/Boat Launch/Non-Motorized Trail/Baseball Stadium area. Increases interconnectivity of Phase II Sidewalk and connects/extends to existing non-motorized grid throughout the City = 887.3 linear feet for \$78,340
