“DUMP YOUR JUNK”

Saturday, September 30, 2023

8:00 am to 2:00 pm (or until dumpsters are full)

The City of Potterville and Benton Charter Township are teaming up to host a “Dump your Junk” **SPECIAL EVENT** for City and Township residents impacted by the storm event of August 24th 2023. This cooperative event is open to residents from the City and Charter Township only, and will be held from 8:00 am to 2:00 pm or until dumpsters are full. The event will be held at the City’s Lake Alliance Park Compost Site, located on the west side of Lake Alliance Park, 301 Alliance Drive, Potterville, MI 44876. If you have junk to dump, please plan on attending the event at 8:00 am, as services will cease once dumpsters are full. Residents may drop off junk mattresses, couches, iron, steel, misc. metals, glass, washers/dryers, refrigerators, stoves, dishwashers, and/or other large rubbish items at no extra charge on event days. Residential rubbish only. Commercial disposal is strictly prohibited. No construction materials or grass clippings are allowed. No tires, PCBs, lead batteries, liquids, hazardous waste, chemicals, paint and/or yard waste. Proof of Potterville City or Benton Township residency is required. All disposable items should be delivered to the Lake Alliance Park Compost Area during event hours. Check “Dump your Junk” Waste Acceptance Guidelines are online at www.pottervillemi.org.
