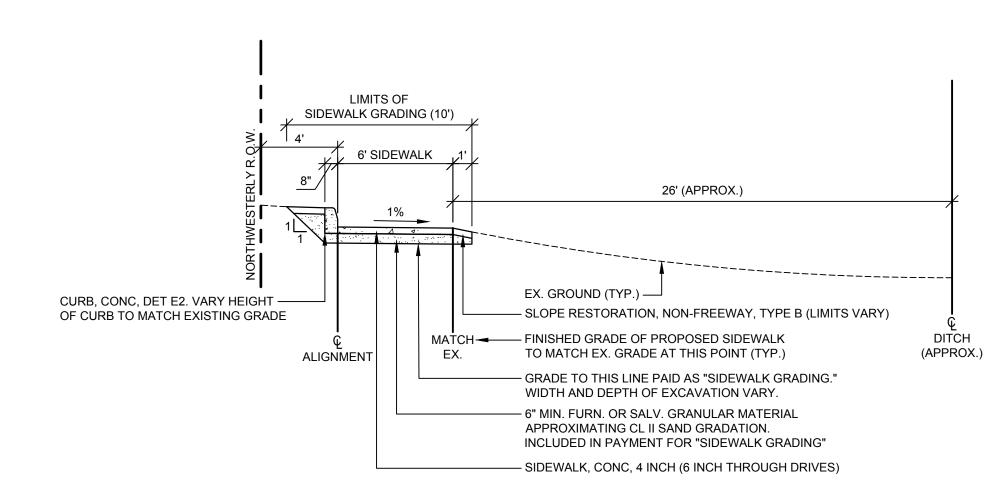


MULCH BLANKET STAPLE PATTERN



S NELSON STREET SIDEWALK PROPOSED TYPICAL SECTION

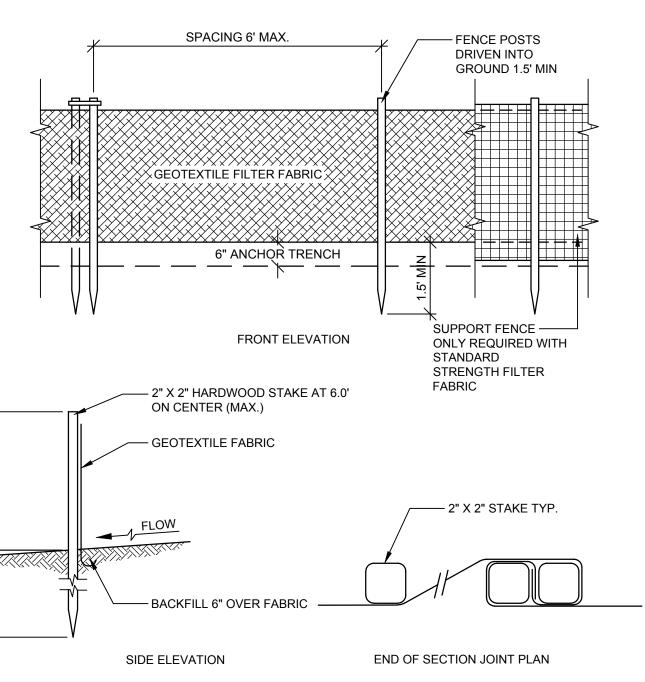

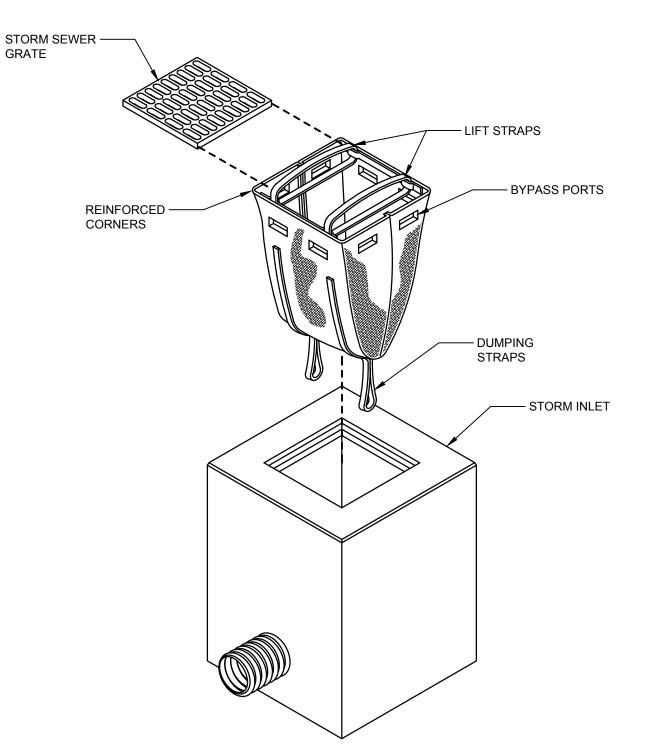
