The Project includes the following Work:

Construction of a water treatment plant which will contain two (2) treatment units with space for a future third unit. Also included will be the installation of a new well into a previously installed and tested casing at the new treatment plant site, interconnecting water main, site work, final connections to raw and finished water main, and extension of the existing SCADA system.
